# Foam Pad (FP) Dock Seal Installation Instructions

(Right or left — read from outside facing building)

 DETERMINE CENTERLINE OF DOOR OPENING ON DOCK FLOOR AND POSITION HEAD PAD OUTER EDGES: Take 1/2 of the head pad width and mark this distance on both sides of the centerline.

NOTE: This will determine the position of the outside of each side pad if head pad mounts across side pads, or the inside position if head pad mounts between side pads.

- ATTACH MOUNTING BRACKETS TO SIDE PADS: Attach two (2) pairs of brackets per pad using lag screws provided.
- 3. MOUNT SIDE PADS TO WALL: Side pads should be placed on mark while bottom of backing is flush with dock floor. Be sure pads are plumb from top to bottom.

#### 4. ATTACH HEAD PAD BRACKETS:


- HEAD PAD ACROSS—attach brackets at each side and center of door opening.
- HEAD PAD BETWEEN—same as Step #2 (if applicable).

### 5. MOUNT HEAD PAD TO WALL:

- HEAD PAD ACROSS—position head pad above side pads with outside edges flush.
- HEAD PAD BETWEEN—center head pad between side pads at specified height (typically flush with side pads across top).

# 6. CAULK BETWEEN HEAD FRAME AND WALL:

Outside edges only. A silicone or butyl rubber caulk is recommended.



# **SUGGESTED MOUNTING METHODS**

(Mounting anchors not included)

**CONCRETE BLOCK OR BRICK WALL:** Try to hit mortar joints. Use 1/2-inch or 3/8 x 4-inch expansion anchors. Use through bolt fastening (minimum two per frame member) if anchors will not hold—3/8-inch threaded rod is recommended.

PRECAST CONCRETE: Same as above.

**METAL SKIN BUILDING:** Through bolt fastening as above. Use a back up plate (steel or wood) to support bolts or anchor through existing building girt or purlin when possible.
